Gloria Dei World Mission Ministry: Reaching Out in Community 2025:

Church of the Wilderness

One of our partner congregations is The Lutheran Church of the Wilderness located on the Stockbridge-Munsee Band of Mohican Reservation near Bowler, WI. It is predominately a Native American congregation. Wanting to honor their heritage as both

Native American and Lutheran, they incorporate aspects from both. Though much of the liturgy and music is traditionally Lutheran, they do sing the doxology in Mohican and English. Smudging, blowing the conch, and spiritual use of tobacco may also be included. Hospitality and welcoming are community values that are reflected in their Friend's Day. Once again, Gloria Dei will send a group of people to this annual event. It is scheduled for Sunday, September 14, 10 am-noon with a meal following. All are welcome. Please sign up on the Kiosk. (Please note: This is a worship service not their Pow Wow, which is scheduled August 9-11). This year Gloria Dei will contribute \$2,000 to the ministry of Church of the Wilderness. Hephatha Lutheran Church, Milwaukee

On June 29, 12 members of Gloria Dei traveled to Hephatha Lutheran Church, Milwaukee and provided a hot meal for over 100 people. During worship an 8th grade graduate was honored for her scholarship and a 14-year-old boy was honored for his leadership in the church and in the community. We also heard from women who traveled to Madison to testify about lead in drinking water. The Dean from Wartburg seminary gave the sermon and a young 4th grader

read from his Spark Bible the story of the lost sheep. He had the congregation laughing with his rendition of a sheep saying Ba-a-a. At the end of the service, Valerie Gulke presented a quilt of affirmations made by Gloria Dei members last Advent. Pastor Mary Martha then shared the story of Gloria Dei's decades-long relationship with Hephatha. She highlighted our caring support during Covid and our recent gift of Culver's cards so that their confirmation class could celebrate. Hephatha is located in one of the poorest neighborhoods in Milwaukee and is a beacon of hope for the community there. When many churches closed or moved to the suburbs, Hephatha stayed. Pastor Mary Martha reminded the congregation, and us, that they are "In the City for Good!" A special thank you to Annette and Don Sikma, who coordinated the meal.
