#### God's Work, Our Hands Sunday

We will have a short service that morning at 9 am and then everyone will be dismissed to do their projects. After our projects we will all meet back at church at 11:30 for a fellowship meal. - 1) Sleep in Heavenly Peace (joint project with 3 other ELCA churches). Ages 12 and older. Making/constructing beds for people in need. Project is located in Oshkosh. Looking for 50-60 people. Volunteers under the guidance of SHP Chapter team members will build bunks in an assembly line setup. There are stations for sawing, sanding, drilling, assembling, staining, and branding the wood. - 2) Worship & Sing at Linwood Community Center. Attend worship service and serve treats to residents. Project is located in Appleton. Looking for 5-40 people.
- 3) Neenah Animal Shelter. Ages 15 and order. Provide help with indoor tasks at the shelter such as dishes, laundry, organizational tasks.

- 4) Quilting at Gloria Dei help put together quilts that will be delivered to Lutheran World Relief, Hephatha, and those in need in our community. If you can tie a knot you can tie a quilt. Looking for 5-15 people.

Coffee House Ministry Planning for 2025-2026 School Year Thursdays from 3:15 - 4:15 p.m.

Informational "Coffee House Meeting" will be held Thur, Sept 11 @ 1:30 p.m. at church for GD members and friends interested in helping with this ministry. Coffee House is a ministry of hospitality and food to Middle School & High School Youth and their families throughout the school year. We provide food (hot foods, treats, beverages and snacks), a safe place for youth to gather, unconditional welcome and acceptance, and a reflection of God's love through our interactions! Gloria Dei volunteers will greet youth, oversee a sign in table, slice/prep treats and food, serve food, distribute beverages, welcome and chat with youth, and do clean up in kitchen/fellowship hall. It takes a crew of about 8-10 each week to make this ministry happen. Volunteers in the past have worked out a loose schedule weekly, biweekly or some other arrangement based on availability, making this a flexible volunteer opportunity. Coffee house begins on Thurs, Oct 2 @ 3:15 -4:15 p.m.
