Advent Theme at Gloria Dei: What do you fear? Insisting on Hope This Advent:

We begin Advent Season at Gloria Dei on Sunday, November 30. This season, we acknowledge the reality of fear in our lives, while recognizing that God is calling us with a new Word, a promise of presence and love through Jesus. **The key for our lives is HOPE!**

Luke's Gospel begins the story of Jesus with this opening line: "In the time of Herod..." This detail may seem minor to us today, however, it reveals layers of information about the fearful world Jesus entered, one filled with rampant oppression, economic disparity, uncertainty, and instability. A world not so unlike our own. And yet, throughout the stories of Christ's birth, we hear the whispers of angels delivering a surprising message: "Do not fear." In our own time, we might ask: is it even possible to be fearless in a fearful world? When Mary, Joseph, the shepherds, and the magi are each called into God's redemptive story, they do not deny their fears—they move through them. They ask questions, hold fast to courage, trust in good news, and say, "Here I am, Lord." When we find ourselves in fearful times, can we acknowledge our fears while also insisting on hope?

To help provide guidance for our spiritual lives this season, we invite you to participate in the following ways:

- Lantern Craft: Please consider helping make a Lamp decoration for church this season. This Sunday, Nov 23, 9:15-10:15 a.m. Children, youth and adults are invited.
- **Devotions:** Devotions around the theme of God's insistence on Hope, in real life, and the promise of God's arrival through Jesus. Available next week: Please pick one up and use at home each day/week this season.
- Advent Brunch: Dec 7 at 9 10:15 a.m. Enjoy fellowship, good food and spiritual care for one another.
- Children's Christmas Program: December 14 @ 10:30 a.m. worship: Signs of the hope of Jesus abound in the
 voices, songs and messages of the children sharing the good news of Jesus.
- Christmas Cantata: 9 a.m. Worship, Sunday December 21: Hear, feel and experience the anticipation of God's gift of love for all creation.
